As we move forward. the rallies have begun, with some already in the books but many still ahead for all of us to enjoy. So much to look forward to and many, many rides to join in on the FUN!



Some Technology Drips Mike Melton, Director of Technology & Communications

Wow... what a title. You may ask, what does that all entail. Well, we will keep that part simple for now. We are the people behind the scenes who send out the On The Fly bulletins, have coordinated and orchestrated our new website, and helps setup all of the Directors so they can see what is going on in their area. We are still babes in the woods, and learning more each day. So your patience is requested, as me move into what promises to be an awesome platform.

I would like to talk about our new website/ platform, and share some tidbits of information to help you to navigate and find the things you want.

Each primary member should have received an email, with your login information. It will contain your username and a temporary password. Please, go sign into the new website and start venturing around. One thing that is important is, you can change your username and password to something you can remember. If you do forget, you can request a password reset on the login page, and look for the email.

Something we highly encourage you to do once you login is to go select a chapter or chapters you want to keep up with. Yes, you can select multiple chapters, in multiple districts or regions. We do not assign anyone to a chapter, so it is up to you to go make your selection.

Without doing this, you may miss out on local, district and regional information. One note here, only the primary member can select chapters, and then that applies to all family members.

Another thing you may want to do is update your family members email addresses. If they would like to receive the On The Fly Bulletins and other emails, we need those email addresses updated.

From the website, if you click on the "Chapters" menu item, it will bring up a map, showing where our chapters are generally located. It is not an exact science, since some chapters cover multiple counties or even metropolitans, but it will be close. Also, if you click on the "View Org. Chart" button in the top right, it will show you a breakdown by Region, District, and Chapters available.

Lastly, you are now empowered. You have the ability to change your personal information (address, phone number, email and etc.) for both yourself, and any family members under you. There are some tricks to doing updates, so look for the "copy from" buttons as you are updating to save you some typing.

I expect to be sending out little tidbits and tips (or drips) over the next few months, to help you to navigate the new platform (it is more than a website).

One more note. As you look at the Chapter, District or Region info, if you see errors, please send me an email with the correct info. If you need assistance, send an email to: eaglewings.web@gmail.com.
